Background

Congenital Heart Disease (CHD) is the third leading cause of infant mortality worldwide, after prematurity and infections. In India alone, over 200,000 children are born with CHD each year, many requiring urgent medical intervention within their first year of life. Sadly, the high cost of specialized treatment, advanced equipment, and medications often puts life-saving care beyond the reach of families with limited means.

To address this urgent need, the Pure Little Hearts Foundation is dedicated to ensuring that no child is denied critical cardiac care due to financial hardship. In just three years of its journey, the foundation has supported more than 500 children in receiving essential treatment

Pure Little Hearts Foundation (PLHF), established in March 2022, is a charitable trust dedicated to saving young lives affected by Congenital Heart Disease (CHD). We ensure that every child—regardless of caste, religion, gender, or where they come from receives the care needed to live a healthy, happy life.






Cardiac Interventions in 3+ years

Guided by its mission to heal little hearts and restore hope, PLHF ensures that every child receives timely interventions, advanced treatment, and compassionate care. All cardiac interventions supported are life-saving in nature. Among the children treated, 54% were under 12 months of age, 64% were boys, and about 96% came from Telangana and Andhra Pradesh. Today, more than 90% of these children are leading healthy, happy lives—each granted a renewed chance at life and a brighter future.




Type of Cardiac Interventions

Laxmanna's Story of Hope and Healing:



Master Laxmanna, a 9-year-old, has lived with a Congenital Heart Defect (CHD) since birth. His father's death in 2021 left his mother, Siddamma, the sole breadwinner, earning only ₹10,000 a month as an agricultural labourer while raising three children. Financial struggles once forced her to give a daughter up for adoption. Recently, district health officials referred Laxmanna to Rainbow Children's Heart Institute, where doctors advised an ASD Device Closure. With the support of Pure Little Hearts Foundation and Aishwarya Trust, Laxmanna underwent successful treatment and is now recovering well.

After losing my husband and struggling to raise three children on a meagre income, I never imagined my son could receive such advanced treatment. Restoring Health & Hope: Yogesh's Story of Resilience



Sri Sai Yogesh, a 6-year-old from Nirmal district, Telangana, comes from a financially struggling family. His mother, Ms. Swati, supports two sons and her mother and grandmother on a modest income of Rs. 6,000 per month through beedi rolling. Abandoned by his father at just six months old, Yogesh was diagnosed with a congenital heart defect shortly after birth. However, due to financial limitations, timely treatment was not possible. Hope arrived when his school teacher informed Swati about a free health camp by Rainbow Children's Heart Institute. After diagnosis, with support of Pure Little Hearts Foundation, Yogesh's cardiac catheterization was successfully performed and now he is back in school and full of dreams.

"As a single mother, I feared losing Yogesh to his heart defect. I couldn't afford treatment and felt helpless. His teacher guided me to a free health camp, and with Pure Little Hearts Foundation's support, Yogesh was treated. Seeing him healthy fills me with gratitude."

Baby of Supriya - Cherished Blessing Healed



The baby of Supriya, the couple's only child born after many years of marriage, was diagnosed during pregnancy with a hole in the heart. Despite advice to terminate, Supriya chose to continue, holding onto hope. Her husband does centric work. After birth, doctors recommended surgery, but financial constraints delayed treatment. At 11 months, when the baby developed severe symptoms, Rainbow Children's Heart Institute (RCHI) advised immediate surgery. With support from the Pure Little Hearts Foundation (PLHF) and their local community, the child underwent successful surgery and is now thriving—a long-awaited dream fulfilled

We waited many years for this child. When doctors detected a heart defect during pregnancy, I chose hope despite advice to terminate. It was painful when we couldn't afford surgery after birth. With PLHF's timely support and help from donors, my baby received treatment in time. Today, our daughter is healthy and smiling, and our dream of parenthood is alive.”

A Heart Healed, A Dream Reborn: Chitti's Journey to Hope



Chitti, a young girl from Vadicherla village in Vikarabad district, battled a life-threatening congenital heart defect from early childhood. The eldest of four children, her parents—Gopal, a construction labourer, and Kavita Bai, a homemaker—struggled to afford the surgery she desperately needed. Years of searching for help saw her condition worsen, stealing away her carefree childhood. Hope arrived at Rainbow Children's Heart Institute, where doctors advised an urgent VSD closure. With Pure Little Hearts Foundation's support, Chitti underwent successful surgery. Now healthy and full of life, she dreams of becoming a doctor, inspired by the compassion she received
